The East Hampton-based company installs customized photovoltaic systems for both older and brand new homes. Beyond the abundant environmental benefits-a 1-kilowatt home solar system prevents 170 pounds of coal from being burned and 300 pounds of carbon dioxide from being released into the atmosphere—switching to solar has plenty of financial bonuses as well. LIPA offers rebates for homeowners using solar power (up to \$35,000), and thanks to President Obama there are loads of federal tax credits in addition to those already given by the state for homeowners who make the switch to green power.
